



Learning at Penlee House Gallery & Museum Penzance

At Penlee House we have a superb collection of paintings by the Newlyn School artists (c.1880 - c.1940), regularly-changing temporary exhibitions, plus galleries which explore the archaeology and social history of West Cornwall.

We offer a variety of **cross-curricular workshops** designed to bring the collections to life, delivered by our experienced and enthusiastic learning team. There is a small charge for workshops and they are available for booking on **Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays**.

We welcome **self-led visits** to the Gallery and offer **free entry** to all pre-booked educational groups. We can also provide a free short introduction to the Gallery and the exhibitions.

Prehistoric Cornwall: Stone Age to Iron Age

**Great for: History - Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age /
Local Study / Art and Design / English - Speaking and Listening
Suitable for: KS2 / KS3
Duration: Full Day or Half Day**

Explore the **archaeology** of West Cornwall with our **prehistoric workshop** and find out how life changed from the **Stone Age** to the **Iron Age**.

See amazing **original artefacts** from the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages; handle replica objects; and take part in **prehistoric-inspired crafts**.

The half-day workshop can be linked with a visit to **Chysauster Iron Age Village**, just outside Penzance, to create a full-day trip (Chysauster is run by English Heritage and visits should be booked separately with them). Or a visit to **Carn Uny** - looked after by Cornwall Heritage Trust.



Celts and Romans in Cornwall

Great for: History - Romans / Local Study / Art and Design / English - Speaking and Listening
Suitable for: KS2 / KS3
Duration: Full Day or Half Day

Discover the **archaeological collections** at Penlee House and find out what life was like in Cornwall before and after the **Roman invasion of Britain in AD43**.

Handle replica artefacts from the **Iron Age** and the **Roman period**, and explore the influence of Roman ideas amongst the fantastic original objects on display.

The half-day workshop can be linked with a visit to **Chysauster Iron Age Village**, just outside Penzance, to create a full-day trip (Chysauster is run by English Heritage and visits should be booked separately with them). Or a visit to **Carn Uny** - looked after by Cornwall Heritage Trust.



Take part in craft activities linked to life in Roman times.



A Picture Paints a Thousand Words

Great for: English - Speaking and Listening / History - Victorians / Local Study

Suitable for: KS1 / KS2

Duration: Half Day

Explore the painting ***School is Out*** by **Elizabeth Forbes** using **role play** and your imagination! Try out **replica objects** and **costumes** to really put yourself in the shoes of the children in the painting.

Experience a taste of a **Victorian school lesson** and work together to build a story around what is happening in the painting.

This painting really is one which paints a thousand words!



Fish and Art: Life in Victorian Newlyn

Great for: History - Victorians / Local Study / Art and Design / English - Speaking and Listening

Suitable for: KS1 / KS2

Duration: Half Day

Travel back in time to **1890** and meet a character from Newlyn.

Hear all about **daily life in the fishing community** and working as models for the 'Newlyn School' artists like **Walter Langley** and **Stanhope Forbes**.

Put yourself in the shoes of the artists by **sketching** our Newlyn resident, then **handle original and replica household objects** similar to those used in the cottages of the fisherfolk and see original artefacts in the Museum.

This cross-curricular workshop provides a great introduction to the Gallery's superb collection of **Newlyn School paintings**.



Penzance Through the Ages

Great for: History - Prehistoric to Victorian / Local Study / Art & Design

English - Speaking and Listening

Suitable for: KS1 / KS2 / KS3

Duration: Full Day

Journey through the history of Penzance and the surrounding area from **Prehistoric times to the present day**.

Focusing on the **Iron Age**, the **Tudor/Stuart** period and the **Victorian era**, explore what life was like through handling replica and original artefacts, hands-on activities and exploring the Gallery.

Make a souvenir magnet and GWR poster and link them to the development of tourism in Penzance.



Behind the Scenes at the Museum

Suitable for: KS1 / KS2 / KS3 / KS4

Duration: full day or half day

Old Toys

**Great for: History - Victorians / Art and Design /
English - Speaking and Listening
Suitable for: EYFS / KS1
Duration: Half Day**

Come and see **toys** from the collections at Penlee House and explore how they are different to your own toys.

Handle and play with replica toys of the kind that would have been played with by children in the past, including **metal clockwork toys** and **wooden toys**. Choose your favourite toy to **sketch**.



Early Years Workshops

Suitable for: EYFS

Duration: Half Day

Join us for exploring, **stories, rhymes, making and doing** at Penlee House in a workshop specially designed for **Early Years children**.

A Museum Adventure

Great for: English—Speaking and Listening / History / Art and Design

Suitable for: EYFS / KS1 / KS2 / KS3 / KS4

Duration: half day

Bring your class to Penlee House and allow them to **explore the Gallery** and follow their own interests.

This workshop uses an enquiry-based learning model, ‘**I see, I notice, I wonder**’, to encourage child-led exploration and thinking skills.

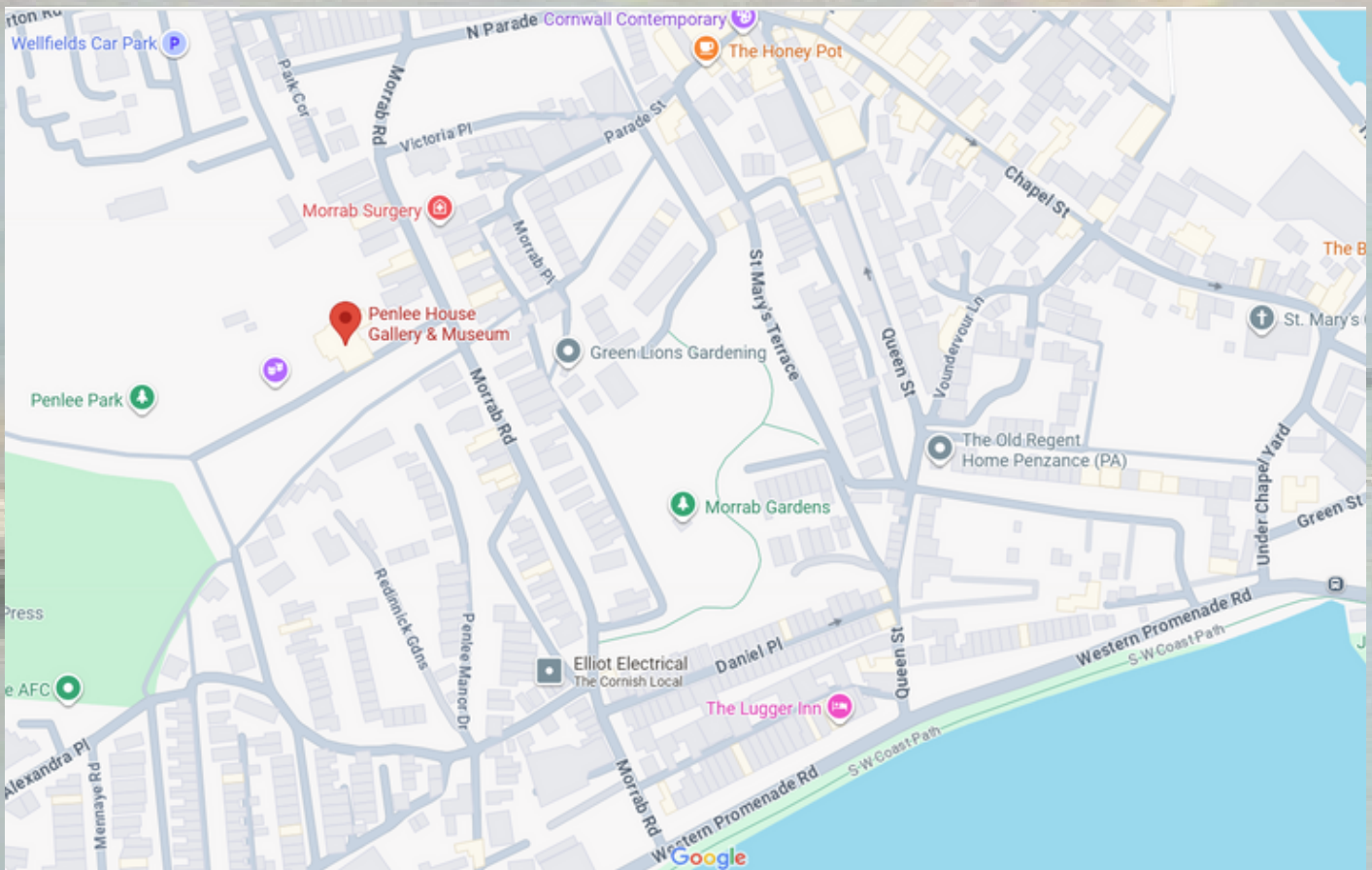
